OUR SENSE OF GOD'S NEXT STEPS IN THE EIFEL

The Call:

- 1 – Go back to the land of your fathers; I will be with you—Genesis 31:3
- 2 – This is to be an Isaac; do not birth an Ishmael—Genesis 17:18-19
- 3 – Prepare the way for the Lord—Matthew 3:3
- 4 – Restore the ancient anointings; you shall raise up the foundations of many generations—Isaiah 58:12
- 5 – Reopen the ancient wells. And Isaac dug again the wells of water that had been dug in the days of Abraham his father, which the Philistines had stopped—Genesis 26:18 (This is where the title *Ancient Wells* came from.)
- 6 – Rebuild the temple; establish the altar—Ezra 1:5
- 7 – I have given you the ministry of reconciliation—2 Corinthians 5:18

Father, what have you said to us since the 2006 Prayer Days in the Eifel?

1 – Do not continue with the Prayer Days in the Eifel as they have been up to now. Through them I have laid a foundation. Now I will build on this foundation. Make space for the new things I will do.

2 – Prayer is to continue to permeate all you do, but I want to take you deeper in prayer. Concentrate on developing leaders and intercessors with the spiritual maturity and authority to ask for whatever they wish according to John 15:7.

3 – This ministry is to take place throughout the year, not just in the summer.

4 – During this next season, the ministry in the Eifel is not to emphasize public meetings. You are to focus on nurturing personal relationships.

5 – Continue apostolic networking. Follow me as I give you friendships in each Christian confession. The process I am unfolding has three sequential phases:

- Phase One (now): Apostolic networking
- Phase Two (gradually): The formation of community
- Phase Three (future): The birthing of a center

6 – Lay the foundations for an altar of ongoing worship and prayer.

7 – Continue to focus on reconciliation

- Between individuals and God
- Between Jew and German (Israel and Germany)
- Between the Messianic church and the Gentile church
- Among Christian confessions
- Within marriage and family
- Among the generations
- Throughout society

8 – Prepare to teach and mentor leaders for a movement of spiritual renewal. Consolidate your teaching. Focus on character development. Apprenticeship to Jesus will play a part. Plow deep. Make yourselves available to those I will bring to you.

9 – Support and serve the coming together of fathers and mothers in Christ for the region. These are those who:

- Have made Jesus Himself the center of their lives and ministry
- Carry a heart longing for the Kingdom of God to come in fullness
- Do not find their primary identity in their own church or organization
- Seek to bring God's Presence to rest over the city or region
- Desire to find other fathers and mothers with whom they can stand and serve together with them in humility, love and spiritual unity
- Are not motivated by personal gain but by serving God and others
- Expect ones from each Christian tradition to be included
- Pray for conditions that will cause Jesus to feel at home in their area
- Understand it is God's Presence that will heal and change the land
